

RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - 7

SPEED LIMIT ON 18th STREET

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wisner, Nebraska, is a legally elected, qualified and acting body and has jurisdiction on a section of road from 18th Street south of US 275 to 13th Street on the southwest edge of Wisner, NE; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the public health and welfare, and on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, which bears on the newly concreted curved road and its new conditions, it is deemed in the public interest that the speed limit on the roadway be reduced as herein set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Wisner, Nebraska, pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statute 60-6,190, that the speed limit of the following described roadway be ordered reduced as described:

Twenty five (25) miles per hour commencing at point "A" (as seen in attached map) and a stop sign at point "C" (as seen on attached map). With the Board of Commissioners of Cuming County, Nebraska adopting a similar resolution to adopt a twenty five (25) miles per hour sign at point "B" (as seen on attached map)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all sign installations shall be made and maintained by Cuming County and in accordance with the most recent edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices".
