The City Council of the City of Wisner, Nebraska met in regular session in the Council Chambers at the City Offices in Wisner, Nebraska, on Monday, August 4, 2025, at 6:00 P.M. Notice of the meeting was posted in three public places which are the Wisner Post Office, Wisner Public Library, and the Wisner City Office. Notice of the meeting and the agenda were mailed or emailed to the mayor and all members of the City Council. A true copy of their signed acknowledgement of the receipt of the advance notice of this meeting and the agenda is filed in the office of the City Clerk/Treasurer. An agenda for the meeting was kept continuously current and was available for public inspection at the City Offices three days before the meeting date. Agenda subjects were contained at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting. The mayor presided and the City Clerk/Treasurer recorded the proceedings of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the general public.

Mayor Soden called the meeting to order and announced the location of the posted Open Meetings Act, pursuant to Section 84-1412(8) of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act. Mayor Soden also announced that this meeting is being recorded.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 4 – STREET & DUMP DEPARTMENT – DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE PURCHASE OF A FRONT-END LOADER. Mr. Woldt explained to the council that he looked over the numbers and there is enough in different departments in purchase of equipment to cover the cost of the front-end loader in the current fiscal year's budget. The amounts and departments are as follows: \$50,000.00 out of Dump, \$30,000.00 out of Street, \$20,000.00 out of Electric, Gas, Sewer, and Water. The cost of the front-end loader is \$159,900.00 from Reuter's and this is a state bid. Moved by Meyer and seconded by Schweers to approve the purchase of a front-end loader from Reuter's in the amount of \$159,900.00. Roll call: Ayes: Meyer, Parker, Schweers, Gobar. Nay: None. AGENDA ITEM NO. 6 – REVIEW BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATIONS. Randy Woldt, City Administrator/Utility Superintendent, stated he has no building permits at this time.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 7 – COMMUNICATIONS, REPORTS, COMMENTS BY COUNCIL, CITY OFFICIALS AND GENERAL PUBLIC.

- A. Councilman Parker stated that August 8th is the last day the pool will be open. There will be an end of the summer party at the pool on Wednesday. The pool memorial party for Cole Uhing went very well that was held on July 23rd.
- B. Councilwoman Gobar asked about the yellow twist slide at the River Park, if it was going to be replaced. It has been talked about replacing it along with some other playground equipment. The yellow twist slide has been blocked off at the top of the slide.
- C. Randy Woldt stated that in the next few days forty trees will be planted from a Forestry grant that was received by the city. The city's cost share of the grant is \$2,500.00. The total cost of the trees is \$7,500.00.
- D. Councilman Schweers asked about the handicap steps going into the pool. The bottom step is higher up from the bottom of the pool. Mr. Woldt explained that the correct way of using the steps is to sit on them and scoot down each step and then be able to stand up into the pool. Mr. Woldt said that he can look into new steps or into a lift. Councilman Schweers also asked how often the portable restrooms at the splash pad get cleaned. Mr. Woldt said every two weeks is how often they are supposed to get cleaned.
